

Directions to Clyde Muirshiel Regional Park: Greenock Cut Visitor Centre

Address: Greenock Cut Visitor Centre, Cornalees Bridge, Loch Thom,
near Greenock, Inverclyde PA16 9LX Tel: 01475 521 458

From Glasgow and Paisley: take M8/A78 to Greenock. Go through Greenock towards Inverkip on the A78. Follow the brown signs for 'Greenock Cut Centre' turning left off the A78 on to a minor road, named Dunrod Road. The Visitor Centre is 3 miles up the minor road next to the Compensation Reservoir at Loch Thom.

Estimated travel time from Paisley is 45 minutes.

From Irvine: take the **A78** north through Largs and Inverkip towards Greenock. ½ mile north of the Bankfoot Roundabout, follow the brown signs for 'Greenock Cut Centre' turning right on to a minor road, named Dunrod Road. The Visitor Centre is 3 miles up the minor road next to the Compensation Reservoir at Loch Thom. Estimated travel time from Irvine is 45 minutes.

Public Transport: There is none directly to the Centre. The nearest train station is Drumfrochar in Greenock. You can walk from the station to the Greenock Cut aqueduct walk via Peat Rd, Papermill Rd and Overton Rd. Or you can walk up Whinhill to the Old Largs Road. Either direction is approximately 5 miles and around 1 hr 50 mins walking time.
